## All staff and students using visual/audio communication must:

- use appropriate language this includes others in your household
- maintain the standard of behaviour expected in school
- not record, store or distribute visual/audio material without permission
- always remain aware that you can be heard by others
- all school work set through remote learning must be, if this is the arrangement:
  - > completed and returned to the relevant member of the education team
  - returned before the deadline set by the education team, if possible
  - completed to the best of the student's ability
  - > the student's own work
  - marked in line with the school's Marking & Feedback Policy
  - returned to the student, once marked, on an agreed date
