What We Do

Bowden House is a residential school, which means some students stay here overnight during the week, while others who live closer to school go home at the end of each day. We have amazing facilities, including special places where older students can live more independently, a gym, sports centre and a school restaurant. Whether you're here overnight or only during the day, we are all part of the same school community.

Our Aim

We want to help you with:

- Your learning: We offer small classes with lots of support so you can reach your potential, catch up, stay on track, and achieve qualifications like GCSEs and BTECs.
- Your personal growth: We provide a caring environment where you can work on your social skills, confidence, and independence.
- Your emotional well-being: We have staff members who are here to support you with any challenges you may face, whether it's with learning, friendships, or emotions.

How We Help You Learn

Our school is different because we focus on "stage not age", which means you work at the level you're ready for, no matter your age. This way, everyone has the chance to make really good progress in their education.

We offer lots of subjects, including English, maths, science, art and PE. There are also lots of other practical courses like **bike maintenance**, **construction**, **food technology**, **forest school**, **music production** and **IT qualifications**. You will also get to do some exciting outdoor activities like climbing, paddle boarding sailing, mountain biking as part of our **Adventure Centre for Education (ACE)**.

Working Together to Support You

Our teaching and residential staff work closely together to support you every day. We also have some experts on-site, like a **Speech and Language Therapist** and a **CAMHS worker**, who help you when you need extra support.

At Bowden House, we believe in celebrating your achievements. We use a points and privilege system to reward good work and positive behaviour, so there's always something to aim for.

Life Skills and Independence

As you get older, we'll help you develop important life skills, like cooking, traveling on your own. We offer the chance to gain work experience and for our older students we can arrange for you to attend local colleges.
